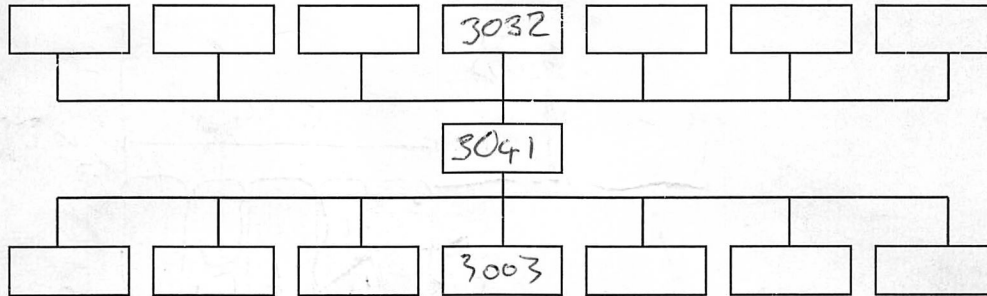

BRICK PAD WHICH EXTERNALLY ABUTS THE BARREL VAULT [3003].		
APPEARS TO HAVE X3 COURSES OF ENGLISH BOND BUT THIS DOES NOT CONTINUE FOR OTHER COURSES - POSSIBLY BECAUSE OF BEST FITTING THE ABUTTING BRICK PAD TO THE BARREL VAULT - SEE SKETCH ON REAR.		
BRICK PAD LIKELY ADDED STABILITY FOR BARREL VAULT ARCHED CEILING & MAY HAVE POSSIBLY BEEN PART OF SUPERSTRUCTURE AROUND		
CONTEMPORARY WITH [3043] & [3042]. FOUNDATION.

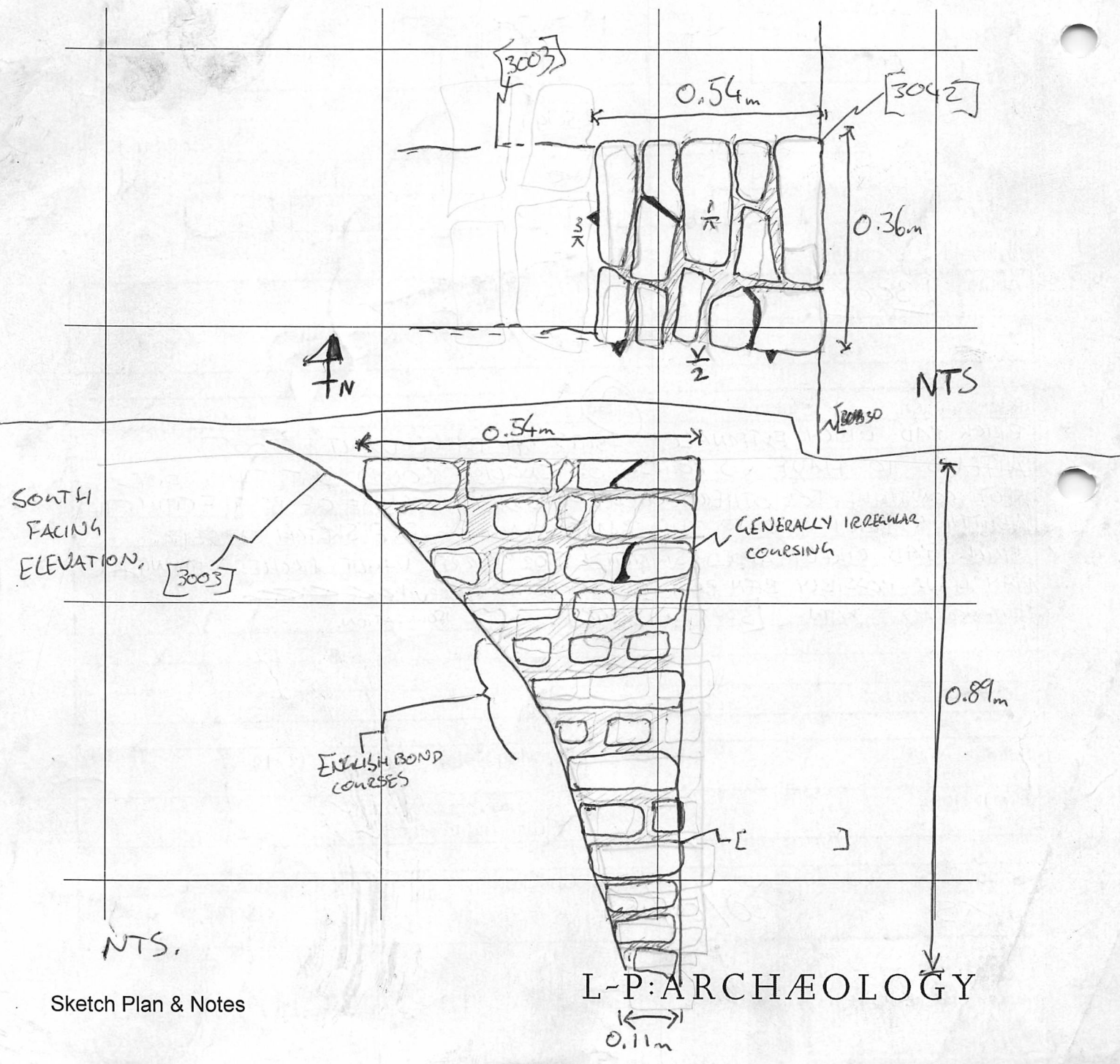
