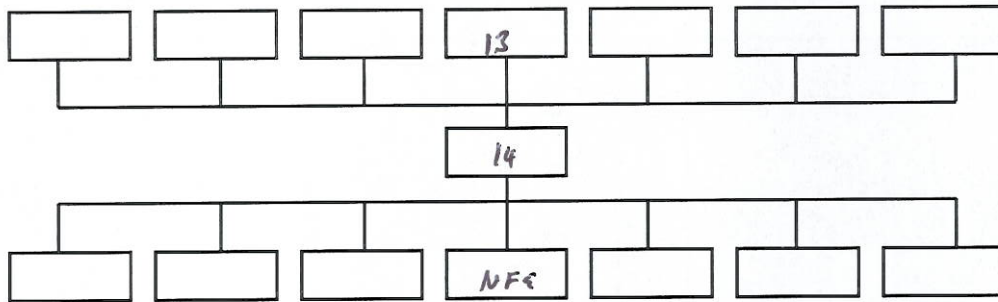

Interpretation:

POST-MEDIEVAL BRICK BARREL VAULT.

TRUNCATED BY CONSTRUCTION OF RAILWAY VIADUCT BY CUT [10]. VAULT IS THEN REPAIRED AS [9] BEFORE FINALLY FALLING OUT OF USE AND BEING BACKFILLED BY CONCRETE (15) - THIS MAY BE RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE DISTRICT LINE

- NOTE DIMENSIONS HARD TO MEASURE ACCURATELY (DIMENSIONS OF BRICKS)
