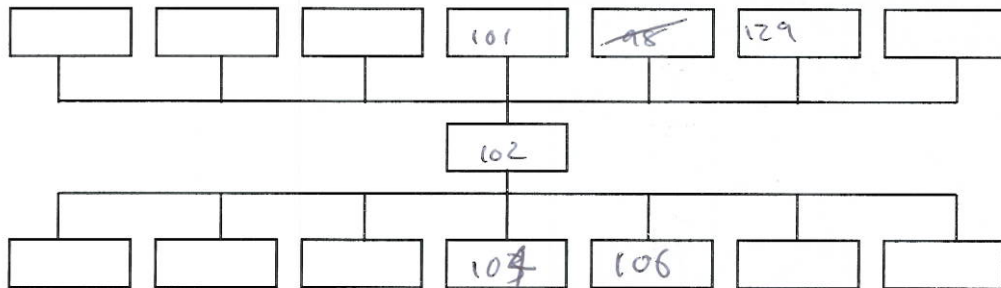

VERY MIXED + TRAMPLED BUT CLOSELY SEPARATE FROM OVERLYING 'TOWN DEPOSITS'. THIS IS A THICK SOIL LAYER, PROBABLY REMOVED. INCREASINGLY CLEAN WITH DEPTH. SURFACE HAS SLIGHT DROOP TO WEST

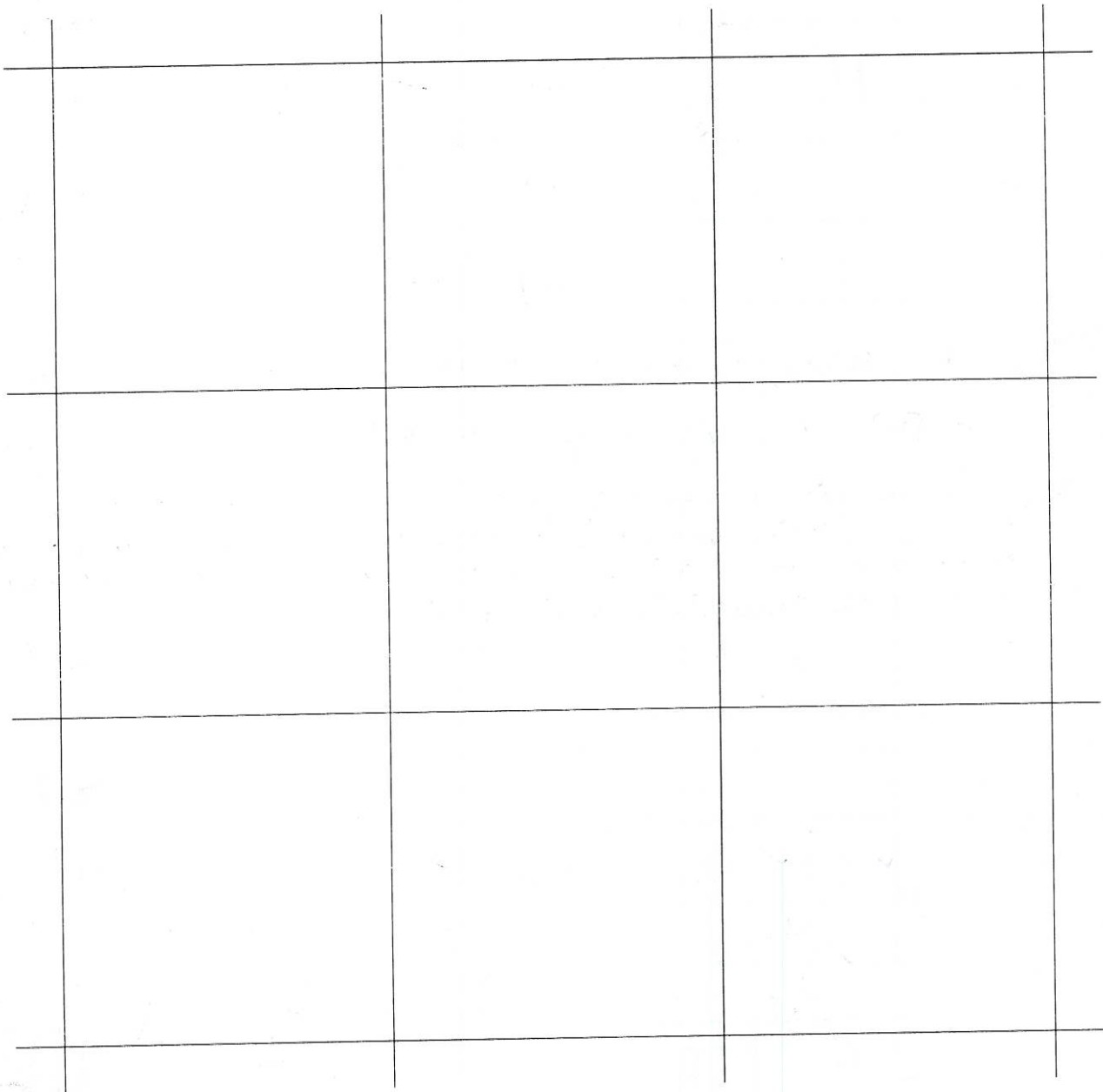
