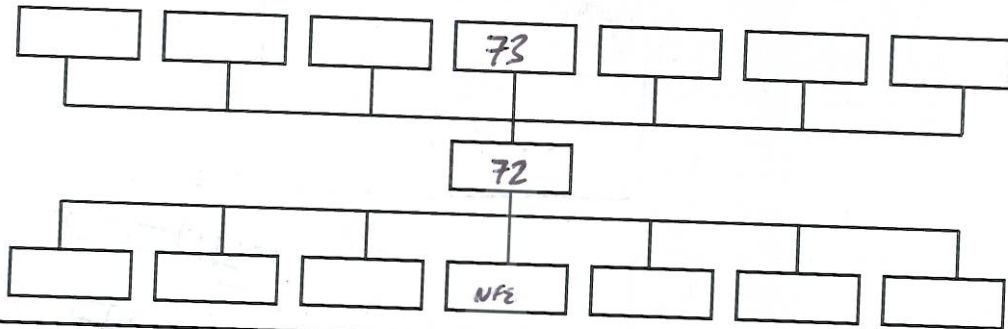

Interpretation:

BRICK DRAIN. SIDES OF DRAIN LINED WITH UNBONDED BRICKS, UP TO 4 COURSES HIGH. APPEAR TO BE A NUMBER OF DIFFERENT BRICKS USED - PRESUMABLY THESE ARE BEING REUSED / RECYCLED.

TO WEST DRAIN IS CARRIED BY UNIT OF 4 BRICKS, TO EAST IT IS CARRIED BY SLABS OF VERY SOFT CREAM SILTSTONE.

DRAIN IS CUT BY [71] + THEN REPAIRED. DRAIN CONTINUES TO WEST UNDER [67] + PROBABLY UNDER FLOOR [69].
