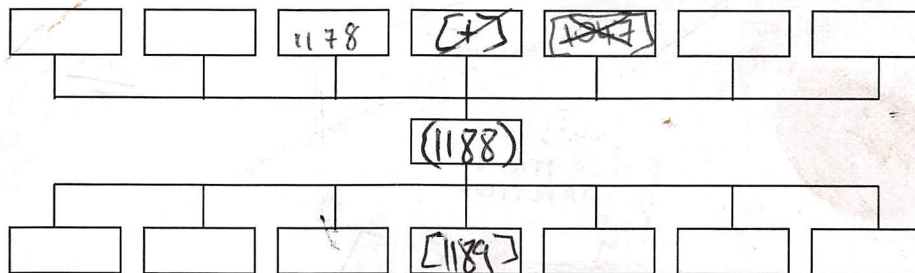

Interpretation:

GRAVEL FILL OF BEDDING TRENCH CUT. THE USE OF ~~THE~~ SMALL STONES AND CBM PIECES MOST LIKELY WERE A DRAINAGE METHOD USED. VERY SHALLOW FILL, BUT VERY SHALLOW CUT ALSO DUE TO THE HORIZONTAL TRUNCATION. IT HAS BEEN TRUNCATED IN THE NORTH BY A FOUNDATION WALL CONSTRUCTION CUT AND IN THE SOUTH BY A DRAIN CONSTRUCTION CUT. FILL SAME AS FILL (1190) IN CUT TO SOUTH. FILLS WERE TRUNCATED BY DRAIN CONSTRUCTION CUT RUNNING EAST-WEST.
