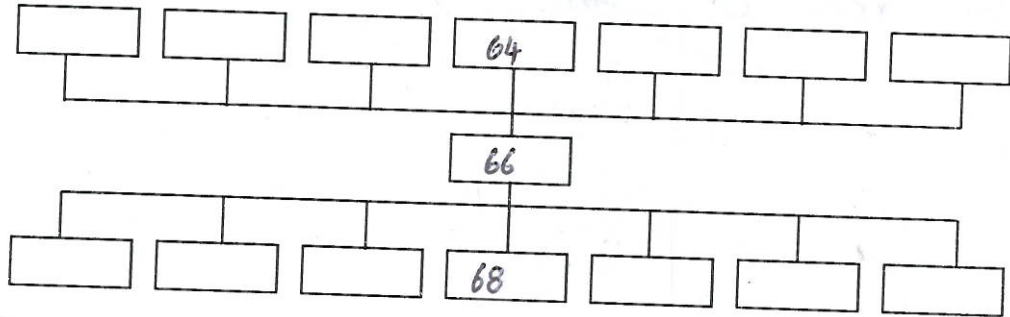

Interpretation:

COMPACT DARK LAYER. CONSTRUCTION MAY BE DUE TO 1960s CONSTRUCTION AS SLAB WAS DIRECTLY ABOVE, BUT ALSO MAY BE PRECED LAYER ASSOCIATED WITH GARDEN CONSTRUCTION, CUT BY [64] CONSTRUCTION CUT FOR WALL [65]. DEPOSIT IS AGAINST WALL [68] MAY BE ACCUMULATE OCCUPATION OR POST CONSTRUCTION LEAVING ASSOCIATED WITH WALL [68].

CUR PIPE APPEARS RELATIVELY EARLY - POSSIBLY EARLY (17th, BUT ONLY ONE BEAN RECOVERED.
